





Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy Desegregation Analysis

This desegregation analysis is in support of Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy's amendment request. To the extent that Ark. Code Ann. §6-23-106 applies to charter renewals or amendments, Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy is required to carefully review the potential impact its operations would have upon the efforts of Rogers School District (RSD) and surrounding districts to comply with court orders and statutory obligations to create and maintain a unitary system of desegregated public schools. Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy is currently located within the boundaries of the Bentonville City limits. Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy currently draws students from the RSD, Springdale School District (SSD), and Bentonville School District (BSD). The charter school currently provides instruction to students in Kindergarten through Twelfth Grade.

II. The Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy Data

According to the 2019-2020 school year enrollment figures as maintained by the ADE Data Center, RSD had a student population of 15,721 students and the entire Benton County has a student enrollment population of 48,196. Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy's 2019-2020 school year enrollment figures show a student population of 1,064 students with 914 if those students in Northwest Arkansas. Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy's current student population is equal to 1% of the entire Benton County student population. Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy is unaware of any federal desegregation court orders affecting the Bentonville, Springdale, Fayetteville, or Rogers School Districts. Under Ark. Code Ann. §6-23-306(6)(A), Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy must be race-neutral and non-discriminatory in its student selection and admission process. While it is impossible to project its future racial composition accurately, Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy will continue to implement admissions policies that are consistent with state and federal laws, regulations, and/or guidelines applicable to charter schools.

In addition, Ark. Code Ann. §6-23-106 requires that the charter operations will not serve to hamper, delay, or in any manner negatively affect the desegregation efforts of a public school district or districts within the state.

III. Conclusion

Northwest Arkansas Classical Academy submits that upon the basis of its review, that the proposed amendment request will not hamper, delay, cause any undue hardship, or in any manner affect the desegregation efforts of the BSD, SSD, FSD, and RSD or any school districts in the State of Arkansas.

To Whom it may Concern:

I would like to make a formal request to purchase land in Rogers for a K-8 Founders campus. Currently we have one campus in Bentonville serving grades K-12 with 850 students enrolled and 603 students on the 2019-2020 waitlist. As with many classical schools, the 9-12 grades are challenging to keep at an enrollment that is sustainable / affordable. Our high school currently has roughly 100 students in grades 9-12. For the 2020-2021 school year, we had 848 students apply for 87 available openings during our open-application period that ran from December 1, 2019 - January 31, 2020.

Because we have so many students in our area on our K-8 waitlist and applying for grades K-8, it makes sense to open another campus that can literally pull from that list for students. By opening another K-8 campus in Rogers, we can then feed both the Rogers and Bentonville campuses into one 9-12 Founders High School. After 2022-2023 (when the lease on the 1300 building expires), we will not be able to accommodate the number of sections needed to roll up the "bubble" and we will have to begin cutting sections. While the initial reaction would be to close the high school, from a marketing and image standpoint, this would be negative attention for Responsive Ed schools in Arkansas. Additionally, that denies students who desire this type of education the ability to participate in it. Given the current state of our elementary waitlist, it would be even worse if we started dropping elementary sections. Once we start cutting sections, the perception in the community will be that our school is not doing well and we will see an overall decrease in enrollment.

We formally request the purchase of 20 acres in north Rogers on the west side of I49 for us to build the Founders Rogers K-8 Campus and the Founders Rogers High School building. This land is 4 miles from our current location on Dodson Road, Rogers.



Current State:

Currently have one campus in Bentonville serving grades K-12 with 850 students enrolled and 603 students on the 2019-2020 waitlist. As with many classical schools, the 9-12 grades are challenging to keep at an enrollment that is sustainable / affordable. Our high school currently has roughly 100 students in grades 9-12. For the 2020-2021 school year, we had 848 students apply for 87 available openings during our open-application period that ran from December 1, 2019 - January 31, 2020.

Opportunities and Challenges:

Because we have so many students in our area on our K-8 waitlist, it makes sense to open another campus that can literally pull from that list for students. By opening another K-8 campus in Rogers, we can then feed both the Rogers and Bentonville campuses into one 9-12 Founders High School. After 2022-2023 (when the lease on the 1300 building expires), we will not be able to accommodate the number of sections needed to roll up the "bubble" and we will have to begin cutting sections. In terms of location, we are seeking a purchasing agreement to acquire 20 acres in north Rogers on the west side of I49. This is land that he would then sell to us for \$2 million for us to build the Founders Rogers K-8 Campus and the Founders Rogers High School building. This land is 4 miles from our current location.
