

<u>Culture in our School:</u> Classrooms on the Nuna, Meade River School's premier Inupiaq cultural and relationship building event, was a success!

For the last four years during the first full week of school, we move the entire school to the tundra. Our focus is on Inupiaq values, traditions, and language, and we find learning is best experienced on the land. Every day we start out with our Morning Meeting which includes a land and elder acknowledgement, blessing, pledge of allegiance in Inupiaq then English, and a conversation about Inupiaq values.

This year, we assigned teams in a cross section of all grades and ages, resembling what one would experience at a whaling or hunting camp. Students held leadership roles such as captain, crewmate, and kimik are selected and each has shared leadership responsibilities throughout the week. We have schoolwide competitions, large group activities, and small group lessons. Students spend the day exploring the nuna where they become the teacher, and our adults are the student.

We were very fortunate to have Susan Hope and Edna Ahmaogak from NSBSD central office, Frieda Nageak from NSBSD School Board and Ilisagvik College, and several other guests to help lead activities. Their expertise added a depth in areas where we could use the help such as sewing, baking, language, storytelling, and aggi. I am hopeful that our NSBSD departments and other guests consider this week a focused, prioritized, and protected time to come assist our efforts. We have many visitors who want to give presentations and lead student activities over the school year, and I invite ASRC to have a presence at next year's event August 18-22, 2025

We need ongoing support to keep the tradition alive. I have been in touch with Superintendent David Vadiveloo and our grants office for support.
