
Justification for fee (include any applicable supporting documentation):

This fee is for immunization and records tracking. The current way of tracking immunizations, CPR and other required documents is done manually by college support staff. Often it takes several weeks of man-hours for completing each student record to be in compliance with regulatory agencies so that the students can begin their clinical rotation on time. The student records have to be verified as complete before each clinical rotation. The proposed fee is for a vendor supported system where communication and upkeep of immunization and other pertinent records are fully managed by the vendor. Because of the sheer volume of students (we have recently added three high school dual credit cohorts and the Health Sciences Academy students along with all our traditional programs), using the service will reduce the possibility of errors such as missing records, and wrongfully certifying a student to be complete with immunizations. In addition, the directors or coordinators will have access for printing reports to satisfy regulatory compliance. Furthermore, clinical sites conduct random audits of student records to make sure we are in compliance. The vendor maintained system allows program directors or clinical coordinators to print the necessary documents on demand.
