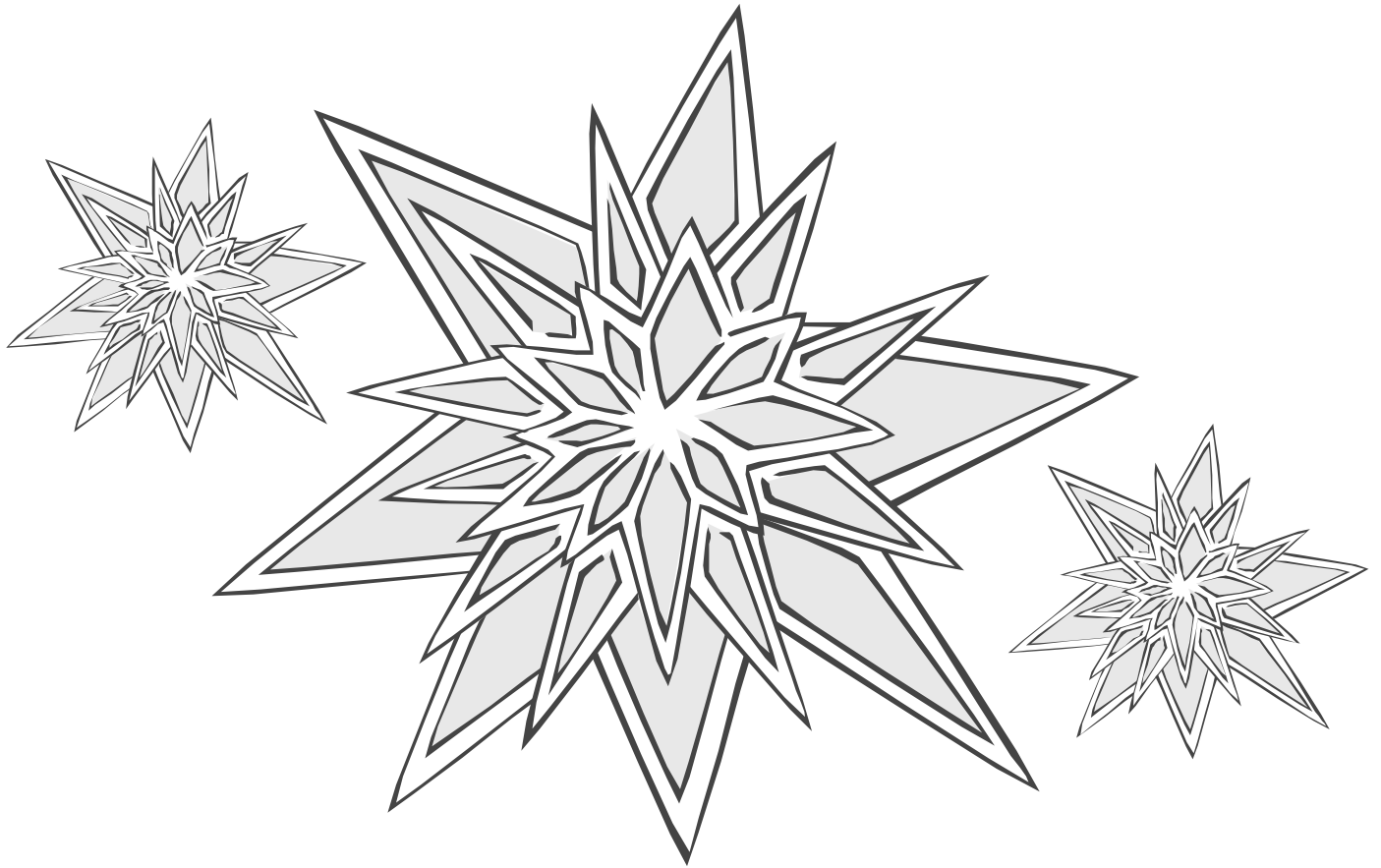

ATTENTION PARENTS

In the event of adverse weather conditions, parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJQ, KLDR, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10), or Three Rivers School District Web Page for information on school bus schedules and school closures. Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

B-02 Pine Tree, Powell Creek Road


B-03 Tetherow, East Fork, Panther Gulch,
