Tupelo Public School District Executive Summary Preparing Sites for Students Return Presented by Charles Laney

We have contracted Servpro to spray all of TPSD sites and offices while school is closed. Servpro monitors all new and current CDC standards for cleaning and follows these recommendations.

The cleaning process will be a two-step process and will include the following:

 $\underline{\mathbf{1}}^{\mathsf{st}}$ Fog - This is an EPA registered food safe disinfectant that will not harm anything in the room. It is a very fine mist of disinfectant that covers all surfaces in the building.

<u>2nd High Touch Point Cleaning-</u> This will include any surface that is roughly 6'-0" down. All doorknobs, Desktops, light fixtures, restroom surfaces, etc.

The schedule for this is as follows and subject to change:

High School- Starts on 03.20.2020 and should take 3-4 days.

All other sites will begin on April 6th and should be completed by April 17th

Once these sites have been sprayed limited access will be allowed to office personal. The Kitchens at Pierce Street, Rankin, Lawndale, King, and Lawhon will remain open and will have limited access to staff and support staff to prepare lunches. These areas will need to treated before students and staff returns to school.
