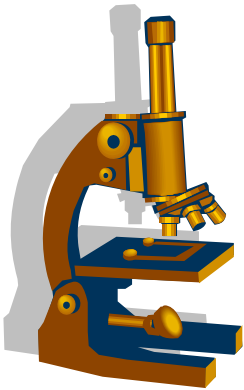

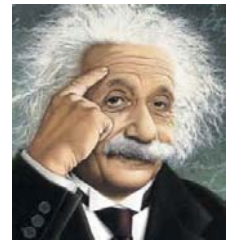


- ⇒ **IMMUNIZATIONS:** If you received paperwork stating your child is due immunizations, this is the last month to take care of that.
