All lots will be evaluated and awarded on a lot basis only.

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In the event the successful bidder experiences a price increase from his source of supply during the term of the contract, the vendor will communicate, in writing, immediately with the buyer, giving the details of the price increase.

1. Before a vendor can raise his bid prices he must request permission in writing, the request must be accompanied by backup letters from his supplier or other documentation substantiating the requested increase.
2. Upon receipt of the vendor's request and supporting documentation, the buyer will contact the vendor's supplier (by telephone or other means) and confirm the price. Every effort will be made to have the vendor's supplier confirm the price increase in writing.
3. After securing and thoroughly reviewing the necessary documentation from the vendors and the vendor's supplier, the buyer will, if satisfied that the price increase is justified, give permission to the vendor to raise her prices.
4. If the buyer is not satisfied with the documentation and believe that the product can be purchased at a lower price, the vendor will be given an opportunity to withdraw his price increase request. If the vendor does not withdraw the request, the buyer will give him a 30-day cancellation notice on the item/s on which a price increase has been requested. The buyer will then proceed to rebid the item/s.
5. If the item/s being cancelled are crucial to the operation of a department such as food services or a school, the budget CFO will authorize emergency purchases until such time as a formal bid can be approved by the Board of Trustees or written quotations can be obtained on the item/s to be rebid.

Note:

A. Price increases will only be considered for the product itself. No consideration will be given on a price increase based on freight, packaging, or increased labor or storage costs.

B. No price increase will be granted on the initial order placed with the vendor by the district.

Bidders must state manufacturer, make, model and/or part number, as applicable, of each item offered. We reserve the right to disregard any bid not so submitted.

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If this bid is not properly signed on page one (1) in designated area, it will be considered non-responsive.

Quantity(s) indicated are the district's best estimate of projected needs for the period of one year and is in no way guaranteed or implied. Payment will be made to successful bidder for actual quantity(s) ordered and received.

Any order resulting from this invitation may be cancelled by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.

Purchaser reserves the right to consider bids not in exact accordance with the specifications to be non-responsive.

The bidder offers and agrees, if this bid is accepted within 30 calendar days, a different period be inserted by the bidder, from the date of opening of bids, to furnish any or all of the items upon which prices are quoted, at the price set opposite each item, delivered at the designated point(s) within the time specified in the delivery schedule.

Due to the time required for evaluation of bids, bidders offering less than forty-five (45) calendar days for acceptance of bid may be considered non-responsive.

Delivery requirements are as established on page one (1) or elsewhere herein and the bid opening time is as specified on page one (1). Award will be made to successful bidder by May 20, 2026. If award is not made by this date, the delivery date(s), as specified by the delivery schedule set forth herein, will be extended by the number of calendar days after the specified award date that the seller receives notice of award.

A formal public bid opening will be held as pertains to this "Invitation and Bid". Vendors submitting quotations may attend the bid opening at the time and place designated on the invitation.

Following to be awarded on a Lot:

LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER

All bids will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder. The determination of the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder may be judged on all or some of the following factors: price, conformity to specifications, facilities and equipment, availability of repair parts, experience, terms of payment, qualifications, past performance, performance or delivery dates, quality and utility of services, supplies, materials or equipment offered and the adaptability of those services, supplies, materials or equipment to the required purpose of CONTRACT, and other objective and accountable factors which are reasonable.

NCS has the option to accept additional promotional specials, discounts or trade-in allowances offered by SUCCESSFUL BIDDER during the term of CONTRACT, but these offers will not be part of the determination for award of this bid unless otherwise specified.

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REJECTION OF BID

NCS D reserves the right to reject any and all bids received by reason of this request. NCS D reserves the right to waive any minor informality or irregularity. Any or all bids may be rejected by the governing body if the governing body determines that any such Bidder is not responsive or responsible or that the quality of the services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor offered does not conform to requirements or if the public interest would be served by such a rejection.

DISQUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS

Bidders may be disqualified, and their bids may be rejected for any of, but not limited to, the following causes:

1. Failure to use the specified Bid Form furnished by NCS D.
2. Lack of signature by an authorized representative.
3. Failure to properly complete the Bid Form.
4. Evidence of collusion among Bidders.
5. Unauthorized alteration to content of the Bid Form.
6. Failure to acknowledge all Addenda issued.

TIE-BIDS

A tie-bid is defined as an instance where bids are received from two or more Bidders who are the low Bidders, and their offers are identical. Bids must be identical in all evaluation areas, e.g., price, quality, delivery, terms and ability to supply, etc. If any of these areas are not identical, it is not considered a tie- bid and NCS D can justify awarding to Bidder with the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The procedure for tie-bids is to hold a public drawing and award the bid to the winner of the draw. When a drawing is necessary, Bidders involved will be contacted with the time and place of the drawing. Attendance is not mandatory for the drawing. An impartial witness will be present at the drawing.

All requests must be received no later than 4:00 p.m. on **March 17, 2026**. Responses deemed necessary will be issued only by written addendum. No interpretation, clarification, or modification of the bid documents shall be binding unless issued by formal addendum. Questions received after the deadline may not be answered.

Bids must be signed by the offerer, sealed and received in the Nye County School District, 484 S. West Street, Pahrump, Nevada 89048 on or before: March 31st, 2026 by 1:30 p.m.

Continuing contract (unless otherwise noted on the first page of "Invitation to Bid".)

Upon award of contract by letter of intent to acceptable bidder(s), prices quoted in this bid are to remain in force from July 1, 2026 until June 30, 2027 with the possibility to extend the resulting agreement for four more years at one year intervals. It is understood that the quantities shown are estimated only, for anticipated purchase during the prescribed period as noted above, and the district is not bound to order any or all of these continuing contract items.

All prices must be in ink or typewritten. No pencil figures or erasures permitted. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections inserted adjacent thereto and must be initialed in ink by the person signing the quotation or a company authorized representative.

Bid on each item separately. Prices must be stated in units specified hereon or trade standard. Each item must be considered separately and not in combination with other items (unless otherwise specified in bid form).

In all cases, wherever practicable, prices quoted should be net, including all trade discounts. All cash discounts shall be taken and computed from the date of delivery of acceptable material or the date of the receipt of the invoice, whichever is the latter.

It is understood that the bidder agrees to deliver, with all transportation charges paid by shipper, all items on which bids are accepted to the addresses indicated on the bid form (page 1). All costs for delivery, or freight, or for the packing of said articles, are to be borne by the bidder.

All containers, drums, carboys, etc., to be returned must be shipped on a no-charge or consignment basis.

Should there be, at any time during the period of deliveries under the contract, a decrease in prices, of the commodities herein provided for, a corresponding decrease will be made in the prices on the balance of the deliveries so long as the lower prices are in effect and the successful bidder shall notify the buyer by letter in event of any such decline in prices.

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Liabilities:

The vendor shall hold the Nye County School District, its officers, agents, servants and employees, harmless from liability of any nature or kind whatsoever on account of use by the publisher or author, manufacturer or agent, of any copyrighted or un-copyrighted composition, secret process, patented or unpatented invention, article or appliance furnished or used under this bid.

Taxes:

School districts are exempt from state retail sales tax, state use tax and federal excise taxes. Taxes are not to be included in the vendor's bid.

Penalties:

In case of default by the vendor, the Nye County School District may procure the articles or services from other sources and may deduct from any unpaid balance due the vendor or collect against the bond, security, or from the surety for the amount of the excess costs so paid, and the prices paid by the Nye County School District shall be considered the prevailing market price at the time such purchase is made.

Excuse For Non-Performance:

The successful vendor(s) shall be excused from performance hereunder during the time and to the extent that they are prevented from obtaining, delivering, or performing in the customary manner by act of God, fire, strike, partial or total interruption of, loss or shortage of transportation facilities, lockout, or commandeering of raw materials, products, plants or facilities by the government, vendor(s) shall provide the school district with satisfactory evidence that the non-performance is due to other than the fault or negligence of the vendor.

Assignment of Contract:

The successful bidder shall agree not to assign, transfer convey, sublet or otherwise dispose of the items appearing on this bid form, which he may be awarded, or any rights accruing there under, title or interest therein, funds to be received hereunder, or any power to execute the same without the consent in writing of the Food Service Coordinator. Notice is hereby given that the district will not honor any assignment made by the contractor unless the consent in writing, as indicated above, has been given.

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Form of Contract:

It shall be understood by the bidder and the school district that the bid received is a signed agreement to furnish all goods and perform all services, including labor (if any), as stipulated in the documents, including specifications and conditions. Upon the award of bid by the board of trustees, the school district purchasing department will issue a numbered purchase order (form of contract) which will serve as a contractual agreement with the successful bidder.

The two (2) documents (the original bid bearing the signature of the bidder and the school district's signed purchase order) become the forms of contractual agreement, agreeing to the performance of all conditions set forth in the bid, the standard bid instructions and conditions.

And special instructions and conditions, including the addenda issued by the initiation and bids. The purchase order to be issued by the school district may be examined at the office of the superintendent.

Warranty:

In addition to any other express warranties made by the seller, seller warrants: (a) that only new materials will be used in items to be delivered under this order: (b) That at the time of delivery to the purchaser, all items work or services (i) will conform to applicable drawings, specifications, samples or other descriptions, (ii) will be free from defects in workmanship and materials, and (iii) whereof sellers design will be free from design defects. All rights under this warranty shall survive acceptance and shall insure to the benefit of, and be enforceable by the purchaser. Seller's obligation under this warranty, unless otherwise specified in this purchase order shall (a) be limited to defects of which seller is notified within twelve (12) months from date of delivery to the purchaser: (b) shall not include consequential damages but shall be limited, at the option of the purchaser, to (i) refunding the original purchase price of the defective item, material, work or services (in which case the purchaser shall, wherever feasible, request and follow any reasonable instructions from seller for disposition of same at seller's expense) plus any transportation charges incurred by the purchaser as a result of the breach, or (ii) replacing or repairing such defective items, or correcting any defective work or services and paying any transportation charges incurred by the purchaser as a result of the breach. In the event of a dispute as to whether a breach of warranty has occurred, seller agrees to proceed diligently with any repairs, replacement or correction directed by the purchaser pending final settlement of the dispute if the seller fails or refuses to replace a defective item within a reasonable time after request by the purchaser, the purchaser may repurchase a replacement and any costs incurred thereby will be chargeable to the account of seller.

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The board of trustees of the Nye County School District shall, in its sole discretion, determine whether or not the bid recommended and accepted by them meets the specifications, instruction to bidders or any other conditions of the bid, and the district's needs. Any bid so accepted and approved by the board of trustees will be final, and not subject to contest by others.

Non-Collusive Bidding Certification:

By submission of this bid, each bidder and each person signing on behalf of any bidder certifies, and in the case of a joint bid each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of his knowledge and belief:

- (1) The prices in this bid have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication, or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other bidder or competitor;
- (2) Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this bid have not been knowingly disclosed by the bidder prior to opening, directly or indirectly, to any other bidder or to any competitor; and
- (3) No attempt has been made or will be made by the bidder to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.

Procurement Law

Procurement law requires sealed bids or proposals. Therefore, Nye County School District cannot accept bids which are transmitted using facsimile equipment. This may not apply to amendments or addenda which do not refer to pricing or to the transmittal of supplemental product literature, drawings, and the like. Please refer the specific situation to the buyer for clarification before proceeding.

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Termination for Cause: Nye County School District may terminate this contract, or any part hereof, for cause in the event of any default by the Contractor, or if the Contractor fails to comply with any contract terms and conditions, or fails to provide Nye County School District, upon request, with adequate assurances of future performance. Nye County School District shall provide the Contractor with a written notice thirty (30) days prior to the contract termination date. In the event of termination for cause, Nye County School District shall not be liable to the Contractor for any amount for supplies or services not accepted, and the Contractor shall be liable to Nye County School District for any and all rights and remedies provided by law. If it is determined that Nye County School District improperly terminated this contract for default, such termination shall be deemed a termination for convenience. The Contractor may also terminate this contract under the same set of aforementioned conditions.

Termination for Convenience: Nye County School District may terminate this contract for any reason, provided that Nye County School District shall be required to provide the Contractor with a prior sixty (60) days' written notice of the effective date of such termination (the "Termination for Convenience Date"). The Contractor may also terminate this contract under the same set of aforementioned conditions.

Clean Air Act

1. The contractor agrees to comply with all applicable standards, orders or regulations issued pursuant to the Clean Air Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 7401 et seq.
2. The contractor agrees to report each violation to Nye County School District and understands and agrees that Nye County School District will, in turn, report each violation as required to assure notification to the appropriate Environmental Protection Agency Regional Office, the Federal awarding agency, or the USDA.
3. The contractor agrees to include these requirements in each subcontract exceeding \$150,000.

Federal Water Pollution Control Act

1. The contractor agrees to comply with all applicable standards, orders, or regulations issued pursuant to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.
2. The contractor agrees to report each violation to Nye County School District and understands and agrees that Nye County School District will, in turn, report each violation as required to assure notification to the appropriate Environmental Protection Agency Regional Office, the Federal awarding agency, or the USDA.
3. The contractor agrees to include these requirements in each subcontract exceeding \$150,000.

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Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment: Contractors who apply or bid for an award of \$100,000 or more shall file the required certification. Each tier certifies to the tier above that it will not and has not used federally-appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a Member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with obtaining any federal contract, grant, or any other award covered by 31 U.S.C. § 1352. Each tier shall also disclose any lobbying with nonfederal funds that takes place in connection with obtaining any federal award. Such disclosures are forwarded from tier to tier up to the recipient who in turn will forward the certification(s) to the awarding agency. If applicable, the contractor must sign and submit to the non-federal entity, a certification regarding lobbying activities.

Buy American Provision:

As required by the Buy American provision, all products must be of domestic origin as required by 7 CFR Part 210.21(d). The District(s) participates in the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program and is required to use the nonprofit food service funds, to the maximum extent practical, to buy domestic commodities or products for Program meals. A "domestic commodity or product" is defined as one that is either produced in the U.S. or is processed in the U.S. substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the U.S. as provided in 7 CFR Part 210.21(d). Substantially means that at least 51 percent of the final processed product consists of agricultural commodities that were grown domestically. Exceptions to the Buy American provision should be used as a last resort; however, an alternative or exception may be approved upon request. To be considered for the alternative or exception, the request must be submitted in writing to a designated official, a minimum of 4 day(s) in advance of delivery. The request must include the:

(a) Alternative substitute(s) that are domestic and meet the required specifications:

- (i) Price of the domestic food alternative substitute(s); and
- (ii) Availability of the domestic alternative substitute(s) in relation to the quantity ordered

(b) Reason for exception: limited/lack of availability or price (include price):

- (i) Price of the domestic food product documenting that the domestic product is significantly higher; and
- (ii) Price of the non-domestic product that meets the required specification of the domestic product.

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Product Specifications & Submission Requirements

1. Nutritional Standards, except where explicitly stated otherwise in the individual line-item description, all items submitted for bid must meet the following nutritional criteria:

- Whole Grains: Grain-based products must consist of fifty-one percent (51%) or more whole grain.
- Trans Fat: All products must contain zero (0) grams of trans fat per serving.
- Additives: Products must be formulated to contain minimal fat, sodium, and sugar.
- Product Preference: Bidders are strongly encouraged to submit products that have a proven track record of popularity and high acceptance rates in other school districts

2. Product Documentation & Child Nutrition (CN) Compliance All submitted product documentation must be clearly identifiable as originating from or authorized by the bidding company.

- CN Labels: Products bearing a current Child Nutrition (CN) Label are preferred.
- Non-CN Labeled Products: If a product does not have a CN label, the bidder must submit a Product Formulation Statement (PFS) on the manufacturer's official letterhead, signed by an authorized representative. The PFS must demonstrate how the processed product contributes to meal pattern requirements by adhering to the following standards:
 - Ingredient Verification: Creditable ingredients listed in the PFS must match descriptions in the USDA Food Buying Guide for Child Nutrition Programs.
 - Credit Calculation: The PFS must explicitly prove how the claimed credit was calculated. It is not acceptable for a manufacturer to simply state that the product provides a certain amount of credit without supporting calculations.
 - Serving Size Cap: The credit a product contributes to meal pattern requirements cannot be greater than the serving size of the product and must be properly rounded down to the nearest 0.25 oz (1/4 oz).
 - Nutrition Panel: A Nutrition Facts panel must be included to verify ingredients and determine if the product credits to the CN meal pattern.
 - Visual Verification: Creditable components must be visible in the finished product.

3. Submission Format & Organization Nutritional specification sheets and CN Labels/PFS documents must be provided for every food product bid.

- Digital Option: A USB thumb drive containing digital copies of these documents is acceptable.
- Paper Option: If providing physical copies, documents must be collated and organized sequentially by Lot Number and Item Number corresponding to the bid sheet.

4. Sealed Bid Instructions Regardless of whether nutritional spec sheets are provided digitally, the Legal Documents and the Official Bid Pricing Sheet must be submitted as physical printed hard copies according to the Bid Publication.
