Re: Interactive Display Purchase Recommendation

The approved 2024-25 Technology Capital Plan included a plan to review and update whole-class interactive technology. The last major purchase of this technology was completed several years ago when all kindergarten through second grade classrooms were provided with this technology. Since then, the existing fleet of displays has aged, the technology has evolved, and the district has invested in a 1:1 device program for these grade levels. Given this, the district sought to understand the future need for this capability and, if determined a need, to decide at which grade(s) this technology best complements 1:1 devices.

During the past school year, a representative committee worked with the Technology and Learning & Teaching departments to consider the unique capabilities of this technology and they reviewed product demonstrations and information. As a result of this work, it was determined that the technology best supports kindergarten students as it allows a teacher, or students, to model how to use and interact with a device, apps, and online services to all students. To that end, the district recommends the following purchase to ensure that the interactive technology in all kindergarten classrooms are updated for the 24-25 school year.

The displays come with a 5-year manufacturer warranty. On a per room basis, costs are 14% under projection. Grant funding will reduce the district's capital need to \$4,600.20.

All agreements are pending Board approval and the finalization of purchase agreement terms and conditions.
