

## *Changes to the Jones Elementary/Intermediate 2012-2013 Student Handbook & Code of Conduct*

**Editorial changes based on the TASB Model Student Handbook:**

P. 25 – Dress and Grooming

Under Hair Styles: fohawks, mohawks, shaved designs, or unnatural hair coloring.

P. 32 – Food Allergies

The district requests to be notified when a student has been diagnosed with a food allergy, especially those allergies that could result in dangerous or possibly life-threatening reactions by inhalation, ingestion, or skin contact with the particular food. It is important to disclose the food to which the student is allergic as well as the nature of the allergic reaction. The district has developed and annually reviews a food allergy management plan, which addresses employee training, dealing with common food allergens, and specific strategies for dealing with students diagnosed with severe food allergies. When the district receives information that a student has a food allergy that puts the student at risk for anaphylaxis, individual care plans will be developed to assist the student in safely accessing the school environment.
