- **Section 2.** The Superintendent of Schools is hereby authorized and directed to secure bids for the demolition of <u>Lincoln School</u>.
- **Section 3.** Said bids shall be secured on a timeline determined by the Superintendent, and shall include demolition, removal, grading, and/or seeding, or other services deemed necessary by the Superintendent.
- **Section 4.** That said bids shall be presented to the Board of Education, at a future board meeting, for consideration or approval in accordance with the Illinois Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1 et seq.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its
