Re: Financing for Capital Project

## **Background:**

The District is considering a \$8.0 million capital project for an addition at Westfield Middle School. The District has just completed the programming phase, which took place last winter/spring. The District is now entering the schematic design stage. The schematic design stage will develop detailed drawings that will determine, including, but not limited to, the building's structure, storm water requirements, and construction materials. In addition, the schematic design will allow our construction manager to provide a more accurate estimate of the costs. In the interim, the District will need to consider funding options for said project.

## Situation:

The District is considering funding the \$8.0 million capital project from two sources; refinancing current debt certificates and fund balance reserves. It is estimated that refinancing our debt will allow the funding of approximately \$1.3 million of the project, while the remaining \$6.7 million estimated constructions costs will require using fund balance reserves. As the District plans for funding this project, there are items that require consideration. They are as follows:

- The Education Fund is projected to have a \$250,000 structural deficit;
- Negotiations;
  - Not knowing the largest expenditure (teacher salaries)
  - Perception of using fund balances for projects vs. staff
- Drawing down our fund balances to 20% or less, how does this compare to the feeder districts (see chart next page);
- Loss of interest income of approximately \$70,000 per year;
- Future capital projects (i.e. roofs);
- Extending debt obligation, limits the District's flexibility;
- Enrollment projections.

## **Recommendation:**

The Administration is not making a recommendation tonight, as this is only a discussion item. The funding of this project will be a consideration for the October 24<sup>th</sup>, Board of Education Meeting.
