3 Building Use Permits submitted:

Westside Community Church – to use the building for worship.

Kids Term – usually have applications submitted in September for fall/winter and December for winter/spring dates. This is the counseling program that has met for many years on Tuesday nights. There are conflicts with some of her dates, so Rod has returned the application to her for revisions.

Softball Tournament / Fundraiser. Happening 6/7, 6/8 and 6/9. They will be using the softball fields and grounds of the school. Approved.

One other issue that was brought up – the Band was informed that they can no longer use the neighborhood for parade practice. Several in the band program are really surprised by this as it is now an issue after 17 years...will look into what permits/permissions need to be filed with the county to allow it in the future.

Principal's Report:

- 1) Bond levy passed so Mike has been reviewing staff for the upcoming year. 3 are moving out of Westview, 8 are moving into Westview and there are a couple more positions that are open – 3 fulltime and a couple of part-time. 4 (3 certified and 1 classified) are retiring.
