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Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) School-Based Mental Health Service Providers 2025-2026

The School-Based Mental Health Service Provider (Presbyterian Children's Homes and Services) agrees to:

- 1. Employ Qualified Mental Health Professional staff (QMHP) with the following qualifications and restrictions:
 - a. Bachelor's Degree in the social sciences,
 - b. Experience in mental health or a related field,
 - c. Supervised by Texas-licensed professional counselor or social worker;
- 2. QMHP's are the sole employees of the Provider and have no employment relationship of any kind with Temple ISD;
- 3. Cover the QMHP's and services they provide under its general liability / malpractice insurance policy;
- 4. QMHP's will not disclose to any third-party information obtained from confidential educational records created and maintained by Temple ISD; and
- 5. QMHP's will follow the following Temple ISD campus protocols:
 - a. QMHP will provide a copy of a Release of Information and a Consent for Two-Way Communication between the Provider and Temple ISD signed by the parent;
 - b. Initial campus visit will be with the school counselor to review district and campus procedures;
 - c. Student will be available for services only during non-academic or elective times, at the discretion of the campus principal;
 - d. QMHP is required to show driver's license and proof of employment with the provider upon signing in at the campus.
 - e. QMHP will be escorted to the designated meeting space and wait for the student to arrive;
 - f. QMHP will alert the campus counselor if the student needs any assistance resulting from the service provided before the end of the session;
 - g. At the end of the service, the QMHP will escort the student directly to the front office; and
 - h. QMHP will meet with the campus counselor at least once per semester to discuss student's progress and strategies for classroom success.

Temple ISD agrees to:

Make available a private space where the QMHP can meet with referred students, their 1. families, and school personnel in a manner that insures confidentially of the information exchanged.

The term of this MOA is the 2025-2026 school year. Either party has the right to cancel this MOA for any reason. This MOA can be terminated by one party giving thirty (30) days written notice.
