I understand I can't go back

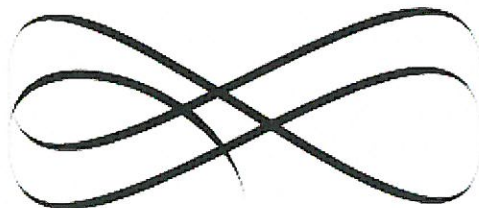
I say I will one day
