

**Fine Arts Integration Training and Support #1010**

- Raise awareness for fine arts integration professional development by publicizing at statewide conventions for administrators, as well as, math, science and fine arts teachers.
- Creation and delivery of a six-hour training to be presented to teachers based upon model lessons.

This training is intended to provide professional development training to teachers of mathematics, science, and fine arts (art, dance, music, theatre), grades K-12, related to effective and appropriate methods of integrated teaching and learning within these three academic disciplines through coordination of lesson plans, instructional strategies, and curricula that is based upon the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). Education Service Center, Region 20 will provide oversight of the project and ensure program goals are met in collaboration with TEA. The center will be compensated for the management of this initiative.

- Host and manage the project website
- Update the Center for Educator Development in Fine Arts “Content Connections” documents
- Implement and evaluate field test with 1,200 teachers
