There will also now be a space available in the high school office for students to meet with military recruiters, college admissions counselors, and potential employers. The small conference room space will provide a professional atmosphere for students to develop relationships with those that will further help them to achieve their goals beyond high school.

School Safety Plan Implemented With Law Enforcement Support

Unity School District's School Safety Plan has been implemented since the start of the school year. The District's employees have undergone training to familiarize themselves with the safety procedures and expectations defined in the plan. Unity School District will be conducting the first of two planned Lockdown drills in the course of the next few weeks. The Polk County Sheriff's Department has been involved in the development of the plan and is also involved in its implementation. With the guidance of the District's school resource officer, Deputy Grimm, the practice drills will be evaluated with feedback provided for further improvement.

Unity School District honored the area's veterans with an assembly on Monday, November 11th in the high school gymnasium. The assembly is an annual tradition where the high school choir and the middle school band share their appreciation of our veterans' sacrifices through their performances.
