RIGHT OF ENTRY AND CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT

This Right of Entry and Construction Agreement (the "Agreement"), dated **December 12, 2024 between the Bunker Hill Elementary Dad's Club** and Spring Branch Independent School District (the "District"). The District and the **BHE Dad's Club** are herein collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

WHEREAS the District is the owner of certain property known as Bunker Hill Elementary School, located at 11950 Taylorcrest Road, Houston, TX 77024 (the "District's Property");

WHEREAS the BHE Dad's Club desires to utilize a portion of the District's Property for the purpose of General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area subject to the terms and conditions set forth below; and

WHEREAS the District desires the BHE Dad's Club to utilize the District's Property for purposes of the General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area subject to the terms and conditions set forth below;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and agreements contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the execution of this Agreement, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Right of Entry.

a. The District hereby grants to the Bunker Hill Elementary Dad's Club applicable employees, contractors, and representatives, a right of entry ("Right of Entry") over and across the District's Property for purposes of General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area, subject to the terms set forth in Section 2(b), below.

2. Construction Requirements.

a. The BHE Dad's Club shall engage the services of Landscapes by Phillip

"Contractor") pursuant to a separate agreement to perform the General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area which shall be performed in accordance with the estimate attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

- b. Prior to the commencement of any installation or construction activities related to the BHE Dad's Club, the BHE Dad's Club shall provide written notice to the District Attn: Travis Stanford, and receive a written notice to proceed from the District setting forth the permitted dates and times to perform such installation and/or construction. In addition, all plans and specifications related to the General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area shall be subject to the District's prior written approval. BHE Dad's Club shall submit all such plans and specifications to the District for its approval, and shall obtain such approval from the District, prior to the commencement of any installation or construction activities by Contractor.
- c. To the extent that any digging or excavation will be necessary in connection with the construction and/or installation of the General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area, the BHE Dad's Club shall first obtain a survey of the subject property to determine the location of any underground utility, fiber optic, and similar facilities and lines, by contacting the Center Point Energy "Call Before You Dig" Service.
- d. The BHE Dad's Club hereby assigns to the District any and all warranties and claims it may have or accrue against Contractor arising out of the BHE Dad's Club agreement with the Contractor and/or Contractor's performance of any work related to the construction or installation of the General Maintenance of the Sport Track and Field Area.
- e. Contractor must satisfy the Insurance Requirements specified in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- f. Prior to the commencement of any installation or construction activities, the BHE Dad's Club shall cause the Contractor to complete and return to the District the "Contractor Certification" regarding the criminal history of covered employees, attached hereto as Exhibit C and incorporated herein by reference.
- g. Any agreement between the the BHE Dad's Club and the Contractor shall provide, and the BHE Dad's Club shall ensure, that all workers on the project are paid the minimum prevailing wage rate adopted by the District, as set forth in Exhibit D. The BHE Dad's Club shall indemnify and hold the District harmless from any and all damages, costs, penalties, fines or other liabilities arising from the BHE Dad's Club's breach of this provision.

3. Miscellaneous.

a. This Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, excluding any conflict of laws rule or principle that might refer the governance or the construction of this Agreement to the law of another jurisdiction.

- b. Subject to any terms or provisions hereof to the contrary, this Agreement shall be effective on the Effective Date and shall remain in effect for a term of 60 days following commencement of the installation and construction activities (the "Term").
- c. This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement and understanding of the Parties with respect to the subject matter contemplated hereby, and supersedes all prior agreements, arrangements, and understandings related to the subject matter hereof.
- d. This Agreement may be amended or modified only by a written instrument executed by both Parties hereto.
- e. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.





WHEREAS the District desires Trees for Houston to utilize the District's Property for purposes of the installation of trees, subject to the terms and conditions set forth below;
NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and agreements contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the execution of this Agreement, the Parties hereby agree as follows:
1. Right of Entry.
a. The District hereby grants to Trees for Houston and applicable employees, contractors, and representatives, a right of entry ("Right of Entry") over and across the District's Property for purposes related to the construction and/or installation of trees, subject to the terms set forth in Section 2(b), below.
2. Construction Requirements.
a. Pine Shadows Elementary shall engage the services of Trees for Houston (the "Contractor") pursuant to a separate agreement to perform the construction and/or installation of the trees , which shall be performed in accordance with the estimate attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.



a. This Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, excluding any conflict of laws rule or principle that might refer the governance or the construction of this Agreement to the law of another jurisdiction.



- b. Subject to any terms or provisions hereof to the contrary, this Agreement shall be effective on the Effective Date and shall remain in effect for a term of 60 days following commencement of the installation and construction activities (the "Term").
- c. This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement and understanding of the Parties with respect to the subject matter contemplated hereby, and supersedes all prior agreements, arrangements, and understandings related to the subject matter hereof.
- d. This Agreement may be amended or modified only by a written instrument executed by both Parties hereto.





Description of Proposal:

MDE Dad's Club would like to install St. Augustine grass sod around the river birch trees on
the east side of the Memorial Drive Elementary courtyard and in front of the school under
the oak trees. The areas were originally mulched, but the mulch eroded and left dirt that
becomes mud after rain. Adding this sod will help reduce erosion in the courtyard, eliminate
the trip and fall hazard created when it rains, and reduce the amount of dirt/mud tracked
through the school. This addition will increase the amount of usable outdoor space at the
campus.

Specifically how does this proposal support teaching and learning/curriculum and objectives:

• MDE has a tradition of gathering in the courtyard before school once a month. This community-building tradition frequently includes students tossing footballs. To keep younger students safe, we have the older students throw the ball on the east side of the courtyard. Currently, the area they use to throw the football is dirt, and that dirt gets tracked into the school. The mud also creates a slip and fall hazard. Allowing us to add sod to the southeast side of the courtyard allows us to use that area for fun health fitness activities. Adding sod to the front creates more usable shady space for parents to wait when picking up children and reduces the chances of a slip-and-fall.
