Re: Library Databases K-12

The district determined there was a need for Library Databases. As a result, the district issued an RFP on February 28, 2022, to select companies to provide resources to support Curriculum and Instruction K-12 through Library Databases. The district received four compliant responses.

The responses were evaluated based on the following criteria:

1. Alignment to the TEKS
2. Content is age-appropriate and developed for the elementary reading comprehension level
3. Content is highly visual and engaging
4. Database Suite provides assessment opportunities
5. Database Suite is available in English and Spanish
6. Availability of Professional Learning or Teacher Resources

The resulting tabulation of those evaluations provided the following suppliers, in ranked order.

Package 1: Elementary Online Database Suite

1. **BrainPOP**
2. **World Book Inc.**
3. **Capstone**

Package 2: A/V Online Interactive Suite

1. **BrainPOP**
2. **World Book Inc.**

Package 3: Online Database for Language Development

1. **World Book Inc.**
2. **InfoBase**

District administration will attempt to negotiate a successful contract with the first ranked vendor, and if unsuccessful, we will move to the next ranked vendor.

The district administration intends to use ESSER funds to cover the cost of this service for at least the first year of the award.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Coppel ISD Board of Trustees approves the administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the recommended suppliers, renewed annually, not to exceed approximately \$100,000 annually, as long as the service continues to meet the needs of the district.
