## **AGREEMENT OF GRANTEE**

As a condition of a total grant of \$240.00 from the Northland Foundation's *KIDS PLUS*Youth in Philanthropy Board to **Duluth Public Schools**, **ISD 709** to support the **Socks for**Tots project, the undersigned agrees:

- 1. To use the funds only for the designated purpose as described in the grant notification letter dated May 4, 2011 and to notify the Northland Foundation of and obtain its consent to any substantial deviations from said grant application.
- 2. To maintain its books and records to show, and separately account for, the funds received under this grant, and to maintain records of expenditures adequate to identify the purposes for which grant funds have been expended.
- 3. To permit the Northland Foundation, at its request, to have complete access to the grantee's files and records for the purpose of making such financial audits, verifications, and investigations as it deems necessary concerning the grant, and to maintain such files and records for a period of at least four years after completion or termination of the project.
- 4. To repay to the Northland Foundation any portion of the grant which is not used for the purposes specified herein or in the grant application.
- 5. To not use the funds for any purpose prohibited by law, and to immediately notify the Northland Foundation of any lawsuit or any proceedings before any federal, state, or local administrative agency, which may be initiated against it.
- 6. Upon completion of the period for which funds were granted, to submit a detailed final report of the activities carried out under the grant, a final expenditures report, and an evaluation of what has been accomplished by the project.
- 7. That the total amount of this grant, or any payment thereof, may be discontinued, modified or withheld at any time when, in the judgment of the Northland Foundation, such action is necessary to comply with requirements of the law.

Here is my report from the meeting of the Grant Selection Committee which met on April 18, 2011.

You can see that there was not good attendance at this meeting but a number of people did get their ratings to me before the meeting. I appreciated that people took the time to do this even though they were unable to attend!

This year we received 8 grants. This was disappointing number. We wonder if this was a result of the things going on in the district regarding school closings and teachers being reassigned to new locations for the 2011-2012 school year. We dispersed all of the money among 7 of the 8 grants submitted. It was a total of \$11,194.00. The grant that did not receive money was the "Stand Up Desks for the Lakewood Learners" grant submitted from staff at Lakewood school. We awarded full dollar requests to 5 of the grants and 2 received a lesser amount than requested.

I would like to thank everyone who made school visits and presented certificates to last year's recipients and who also provided treats. I also want to thank Sue Stelman for filling in for me by taking care of some grant committee work when I ended up having emergency back surgery and needed quite a lot of time for my recovery. Finally, I would like to thank John Gustafson (DSACF) for his help at this meeting, John Blevins (DSACF), and all the grant committee members for their participation!
