- Madrona is having our first annual TRUNK OR TREAT, 30+ parent volunteers are decorating their cars and parking in our secured parking lot for our fun event on October 30th. Abbey's Pizza donated 400 bags for our special event.

- 5. Mr. Rob Harrington, our fourth grade teacher, is going to be teaching an after school class for Science at Lincoln Savage. This is part of the 21st Century Grant, with a vision of strengthening the bridge between middle school and elementary.
- 6. October 6th wrapped up our READING FOR EDUCATION fund raiser; we raised roughly \$300.00 and these funds are used to enhance our computer lab needs.
