Emergent Bilingual Scholar Enrollment Information




Emergent Bilingual Scholar Enrollment

Texas Education Code (TEC), §29.056(g), states that the LPAC may reclassify an EB student as English proficient at the end of the school year in which the student meets the <u>reclassification criteria</u> and is determined to be able to successfully participate in an English instructional program with no second language acquisition supports. Please see table below for grade-level specific exit criteria for reclassification.

To meet Exit criteria, ALL EB scholars from grade 3 to grade 8 must meet the following:

- TELPAS: Advanced High Composite score
- STAAR: Approaches Grade Level or higher on English Reading
- 3. Obtain Teacher Subjective Evaluation Form: Satisfactory

To meet Exit criteria, ALL EB scholars from grade 9th and 10th grade must meet the following:

- 1. TELPAS: Advanced High Composite score
- 2. STAAR: Approaches Grade Level or higher on EOC (EOC Eng 1 for 9th and EOC Eng 2 for 10th).
- 3. Obtain Teacher Subjective Evaluation Form: Satisfactory

To meet Exit criteria, ALL EB scholars from grade 11th and 12th grade must meet the following:

- TELPAS: Advanced High Composite score
- Score in the 40th percentile or above on TEA Approved Norm-Referenced Standardized Achievement Test: Iowa, Form F for Reading and Language Arts
- Obtain Teacher Subjective Evaluation Form: Satisfactory

Manor ISD TELPAS 2024 Secondary Composite Rating Distribution: *Manor ISD vs. State*




Emergent Bilingual Academic Performance May 2024 3rd Grade STAAR Spanish Reading Language Arts








Emergent Bilingual Academic Performance May 2024 4th Grade STAAR Spanish Reading Language Arts

Manor ISD Comprehensive District Professional Learning Plan

When a request for BE exceptions/ESL waivers are submitted the school district shall include an assurance that a comprehensive professional development plan that is ongoing and targets the development of the knowledge, skills, and competencies needed to serve the needs of Emergent Bilingual scholars is created and delivered to those teachers on bilingual exceptions and ESL waivers.

- New Teacher Orientation and Back to School professional learning - August 2023
- DL Academy–4 days of professional learning for teachers
- DL Academy for Leaders (district and campus leaders)
- District ESL academy opportunities for ESL certification (Internal)
- Monthly professional learning opportunities
 - District Principal meetings
 - ILT monthly meetings
 - Biliteracy curriculum workshops
- Compliance trainings for campus LPAC administrators and virtual and on-campus support as needed to LPAC administrators
- District-wide Content-Based Language Instruction (sheltered instruction) professional development

- Partnership with Dr. Zelaya Education consulting in supporting our EB newcomer scholars and campus staff with the Manor ISD EB Secondary Newcomer Empowerment
 - Instructional strategies toolkit
 - Post-secondary education support
- Elementary campuses participation in the Texas Dual Language Project with Ensemble Learning which includes:
 - Professional Learning
 - Campus administration campus walkthroughs using the TDLIF walkthrough tool
 - Instructional coaching support for dual language teachers
 - Bilingual certification support

Bilingual/ESL Certification Opportunities



Multilingual Edcuation Department Certification Opportunities

- Comprehensive professional learning plan for our teachers on bilingual exceptions and ESL waivers that were targeted to the competencies needed to serve the needs of our EB scholars throughout the school year
 - Ensemble Learning partnership to provide additional instructional coaching for campus leadership teams and dual language teachers beyond the TDLP grant
- Preparation for teachers in taking the Bilingual and ESL certification exams through virtual and in-person certification prep courses as well as TEA free courses
 - Registration fees & testing materials paid for test prep course -bilingual/ESL certification exams.
 - Manor ISD ESL Academy offered by the Multilingual Education department
 - Multilingual Department will reimburse elementary and secondary content-area teachers who serve emergent bilingual scholars for the exam if they pass and have the endorsement added to their certificates
 - Extra-duty pay if certification prep courses offered outside of contract hours

Recruiting Endeavors



- Continued participation in the J1 Visiting International Teaching initiative program to staff our schools with needed bilingual educators
 - Recruited 4 elementary teachers from Spain through the Region 13 VIT program for the 2023-2024 school year
 - Onboarding professional development provided by Multilingual Education department through the DL Academy
 - Onboarded 4 more elementary teachers from Spain for our dual language classrooms for the 2024-2025 school year
- Bilingual Stipend offer for certified bilingual teachers
- Continued collaboration with Human Capital to participate in various job fairs virtually and in-person throughout the school year

Parental Engagement Plan

District Improvement Goal 3: COMMUNITY & FAMILY ENGAGEMENT- By 2026, Manor ISD will collaboratively engage in opportunities with 100% of families, as well as new and existing community partners.
