Classroom Technology

- We are currently installing 60 new printers for classrooms that don't currently have one. Printers will now be assigned to a room permanently and not follow staff as they move around.
- We installed 8 new desktop computers that were ordered by Mt. Harrison High school.
- We are going to replace 30 teacher laptops in the spring instead of the fall. We hope this is a better time without the conflicts of starting school.
- We installed a video wall in the technology room at the High School. This was funded by an ARTEC grant. Electrical work is all that is left.



Security/Video

- We added 4 new security cameras at East Minico and 4 new security cameras at West Minico to cover the north hallways and cafeteria area. When we install a new camera, it requires new wiring as well.
- Electronic Locks at the District Service center have been changed to allow constant communication to a centrally controlled system. All of the rest of the schools with electronic door locks will be switched out in the next few months. We are also adding some locks to help secure the buildings better.
