### **Purpose of Report**

The TASB Board of Directors is charged with carrying out directives established by the Delegates at the Delegate Assembly. The individual Director is expected to attend four Board meetings a year, with one of the meetings being at the same time as the annual TASA/TASB Convention. In addition, the Director will be asked to serve on a standing committee that will meet, as needed, in conjunction with Board meetings. The Director should be a capable, experienced school board member who can assist in providing the Association with outstanding leadership.

TASB has invited school districts within Region 11 to nominate a trustee from their school boards to fill the Region 11, Position A seat on the TASB Board that is being vacated by Bobby J. Rigues from Aledo ISD.

To nominate an individual the following forms must be completed: 1. Active member's nomination and candidate's willingness to serve 2. Candidate biographical sketch 3. Candidate questionnaire

### **Objectives**

- To submit a nominee from Denton ISD school board for the expiring position on the TASB Board in TASB Region 11, Position A.
- A district's nomination of an individual also serves as an endorsement for that candidate.

### **Operational Impact**

Directors serve 3-year terms, once elected to a 3-year term, they can be elected to maximum of 3 additional terms.
