Agenda Item: Consider Approval of CSP 2526-007 Terrell HS Track Resurfacing

Summary:

On February 2, 2026, the Board of Trustees approved the modification of Bond 2025 procurement methods to include Competitive Sealed Proposal or Interlocal Contract (purchasing cooperative).

On March 10, 2026, the Competitive Sealed Proposal procurement method was issued for the 2025 Bond voter approved Terrell HS Track Resurface project. The CSP was for demolition of existing track synthetic surfacing, repairs to subbase, drainage repairs, and installation of new synthetic surface with regulation striping.

On March 31, 2026, the district received five (5) proposals for this CSP. All responses were evaluated and ranked based on advertised criteria and best value for the District. Symmetry Sports Construction is the highest-ranking company.

This work will be funded from the 2025 Bond Construction Fund and is within budget.

Administrative Recommendation:

It is the recommendation of the Superintendent for the Board of Trustees to approve the ranking of Terrell HS Track Resurfacing providers as presented and delegate the authority to the Superintendent to negotiate and execute a contract with the highest ranking company, Symmetry Sports Construction. If an agreement is not reached, the district will end negotiations with that vendor and proceed to the next vendor in order of ranking until a contract is reached or all proposals are rejected. The not to exceed value is \$800,000.00 for all proposed work.
