The primary update to the proposed instructional calendar for GCISD is to the instructional minutes per day. All schools will begin five minutes earlier than the previous year, and dismiss five minutes later than the previous year, for a total of ten additional instructional minutes per day. This update allows GCISD to designate two instructional planning days within a teacher's 187-day contract where students will be out of school, while also keeping the school year beginning on a Wednesday and still concluding before Memorial Day. These days are *not* for professional development, but rather designate time at the end of grading periods for staff to plan with teams, analyze data, hold professional learning communities (PLCs), and address any additional classroom needs.

After incorporating the given parameters, input was gathered from the District leadership team, campus leadership, and various departments. The proposed calendars were presented and reviewed by the District Excellence Committee (DEC) on September 26, 2024. Draft calendars were reviewed, and further input was sought from campus leadership and District staff. Feedback was used at each phase to make changes to the drafts and create new drafts.

Since the feedback from each of these groups overwhelmingly favored one draft calendar, the District is recommending the proposed 25-26 instructional calendar for Board approval.
