On August 25, 2025 at 6:00 p.m., the Board of Trustees met in special session in the Board Room of the District Services Facility, 1100 Longhorn Drive, Weatherford, Texas, the meeting being open to the public.

Open Forum:

No one addressed the Board at this time.

New Business

Jeff Ford moved to approve to approve the Resolution to Declare a Good Cause Exception for House Bill 3 as presented. Adam Feriend seconded. Motion passed.

Brian Catlin arrived.

Final Amendments of the 2024-2025 Budget were presented for approval with a motion by Adam Feriend. Wally Wallace seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Proposed 2025-2026 budget and tax rate information was presented. Mike Guest opened the public hearing at 6:17 p.m. With no one present to address the board, the hearing was closed at 6:18 p.m.

After a motion by Adam Feriend and a second from Jeff Ford, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the 2025-2026 budgets for General Fund, Interest and Sinking, and Child Nutrition.

Kindra Lucia moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$1.0342, which is effectively a .59 percentage increase in the tax rate and approve the ordinance setting the 2025 tax rate at \$.7552 for Maintenance and Operations and \$.2790 for Interest and Sinking for a total tax rate of \$1.0342 per one hundred dollars in valuation. Wally Wallace seconded the motion. Motion passed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:22 p.m.
