# The Board of Trustees Red Wing Public Schools - ISD 256

An Operations Committee of the Board of Trustees of Red Wing Public Schools - ISD 256 was held Monday, February 1, 2021, beginning at 4:45 PM via Google Meets

#### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1. Call to Order and Roll Call

#### 2. Business Items

#### 2.1. Burnside Parking Lot

Kevin Johnson, Director of Buildings, Grounds, and Technology provided an update on the Burnside Parking Lot Project.

- Very good project. Made a few minor changes such as narrowing the exit to encourage people not to enter. Safety issue. Added grass and removed some asphalt. These savings allowed us to add a few more concrete repairs.
- Did not have to use most of our contingency. \$51,071 of \$59,065 will not be used and will go back into our LTFM budget for other projects.
- Holding \$40, 633 until all punch list items are completed.

#### 2.2. Twin Bluff Playground

Chris Palmatier, Twin Bluff Principal, and Alan Gaylor, Buildings and Grounds Director presented preliminary ideas for a playground at Twin Bluff. The committee discussed location, playground options and fundraising efforts.

## 2.3. Sunnyside Kitchen Wall Repair Project

The committee recommended the acceptance of the bid from Red Wing Construction in the amount of \$30,696 for the Sunnyside Kitchen Wall Repair project.

- Received two bids. Red Wing Construction \$30,696 & Met Construction \$42,900.
- Wall repairs are due to the freezer floor not having a thermal break installed when it was new. The sweating will ruin the wall and could create a mold condition. Custodians have been doing a really nice job keeping the wall sanitized and dry.

• Due to this very good bid by Red Wing Construction, also a local company, we were able to lower our budget by \$13,564.

## 2.4. Other Issues

Kevin Johnson provided an update on the HBC lease.

- The school's attorney has reviewed the tower\fiber use. We will make a few very minor changes and include a detailed list of fiber used by the school district along with a map.
- A final contract will be shared with the committee as soon as it is finalized.
