**DISCUSSION:** A tuition increase is being recommended for the academic

year of 2021-2022 of \$3.00 per rate:

County Resident – from \$52.00 to \$55.00

Out-of-County Resident – from \$98.00 to \$101.00

• Out-of-State/Country Resident – from \$165.00 to

\$168.00

The Board's goal of having revenue from state appropriations, tuition, and fees to equal instructional expenses to ensure the financial stability of Collin College will be met with the increased tuition rates for the coming

academic year.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

The District President recommends that the Board of Trustees approves the tuition rates of \$55.00 per credit hour for in-county residents, \$101.00 per credit hour for out-of-county residents and \$168.00 per credit hour for out-of-state/out-of-country residents, effective fall 2021. This is

an increase in tuition.
