## Instruction

## **Education of Homeless Children**

Each child of a homeless individual and each homeless youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, as provided to other children and youths, including a public pre-school education. A *Ehomeless child?* is defined as provided in the McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and State-law. the III. Education for Homeless Children Act. The Executive Director or designee shall act as or appoint a Liaison for Homeless Children to coordinate this policy's implementation.

A homeless child may attend MVSEC programs if: (a) the child currently lives in any Member District's attendance areas; or (b) the child when permanently housed resided in a Member District or was enrolled in a Member District school.
