Greetings from HHS!

As we begin to approach spring time we are gearing up for some of our spring assessments here at the high school. The ASVAB test which was administered on January 29th saw 55 of our students participate. This was a larger group of students to participate than what we have seen in the past. I think partly it is due to having our personal Military Liaison here with sergeant Pilkington. The ASVAB is used to determine a person's eligibility for enlistment in the United States Armed Forces. It is also used to help find the right career for a person. I was able to get a sneak peak on some of our test results and we had a couple of students score in the 99th percentile in specific areas. Sergeant Pilkington will be reviewing test results with each student on the 20th. We have SAT and ISAT assessments also coming up in March and April this semester and we are preparing our students in hopes to get great results this spring.

There has been a large percentage of students and staff alike absent these past few weeks due to illness. We are hoping that it all passes soon so that we can get everyone on track for a great second semester.

This month our PBIS theme is Responsible as we revisit each of our themes during the second semester. The District themes of being Respectful, Responsible, Safe, and having a positive attitude are all characteristics that we feel are important to the success of our students both now and as they transition into life beyond high school.

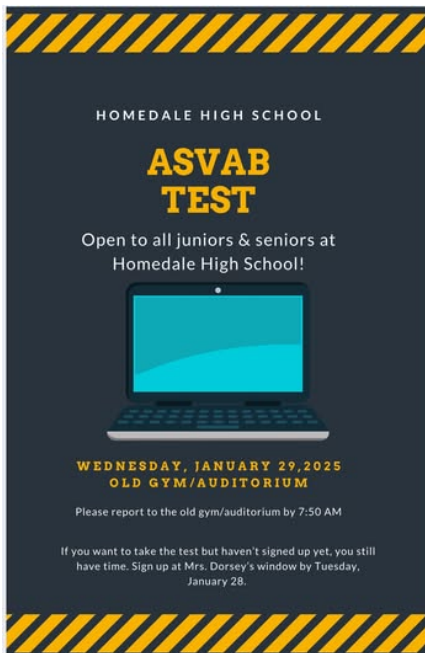
