#### **FY25 Notable Changes**

- Larger tax receipts received in June of 2024
- Decrease in Federal dollars (ESSER ends September 2024)
- Slight decrease in investment returns
- Tier 4-No new EBF dollars
- Salary increases in response to wage inflation
- Second year of large increases in all types of insurance
- Continued support of Capital Projects
- Inflation impacts cost to do business
