Recommendation:

This item is presented for information only in Executive Session. Administration will provide the Board of Trustees with the executive summary of the District's Physical Security Audit in compliance with state requirements.

Rationale:

Texas law requires school districts to conduct periodic safety and security audits of district facilities and provide results to the Board of Trustees. The executive summary reflects the overall findings of the audit, including identified vulnerabilities and corresponding corrective actions.

The detailed audit report contains sensitive security information and is therefore reviewed in Executive Session to protect the integrity of district safety measures. The executive summary provides the Board with a high-level overview of the district's security posture and compliance with statutory requirements.

Grand Prairie ISD's most recent audit identified the district as meeting or exceeding required standards, with any noted campus-level findings addressed through established corrective action processes.
