



### ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS PROJECT TEAM MEMBESHIP

### POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION:

In accordance with Administrative Regulation II/II-AR, the Board is to affirm project team membership prior to the commencement of the curriculum review process. The Superintendent hereby submits the membership of the English Language Arts Project Team (see attachment).

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Board directed the Superintendent to form the English Language Arts Project Team for the purpose of conducting a curriculum review according to the District's Quality Curriculum Cycle guidelines at the September 29, 2014 Board meeting. This opportunity was communicated in the media and on the District website (see attachment).

The posted criteria were applied in the selection process:

- Balance and diversity in perspectives, program/assignment, region and grade level representation are the essential criteria
- Expertise, experience and demonstrated leadership are also considerations
- Number of participants meets minimum posted membership requirement

Each selected individual will be contacted to affirm non-conflict of interest and willingness to strive towards the expectations of the role. As is contractually required, BEA will be provided a preview of this roster and have the option of adding another teacher name to the Project Team membership.

Students will be members of a project team recruited by Teaching & Learning and school administrators

The project team will begin work in December. The first meeting is scheduled for December 2, 2014.

### RECOMMENDATION:

(14-475) It is recommended that the School Board affirm the English Language Arts Project Team membership

# District Seeks applicants for English Language Arts Project Team

Teachers, parents, and community members are encouraged to apply to serve on the Beaverton School District's English Language Arts Project Team. The Project Team's work will begin in November, 2014 and will conclude by June, 2015. Administrators are asked to communicate this opportunity to staff, parents, and community members.

The English Language Arts Project Team will review existing English Language Arts Curriculum and practices in order to make curriculum and adoption recommendations to the School Board. The Project Team and supporting cadres will be charged with:

- Researching best practices and instructional materials to be considered for possible adoption in English Language Arts
- Articulating long term and supporting learning targets and assessments in English Language Arts
- Recommending professional development and structures for ongoing professional learning

The Beaverton School District reviews and updates its curriculum, instructional practices, and classroom materials according to Board policy and Oregon State Statute and Administrative Regulations.

- Specialists for: Sped, TAG, ESL, Intervention, IT, Library Media, TeacherSource (7)
- Board Representative (1)

Administrative Support: Administrators for Elementary & Secondary Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessment.
