DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEM

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the recommendations of the new district attendance lines and campus boundaries.

IMPACT/RATIONALE:

These recommendations will balance student enrollment, address capacity challenges, and position Judson Independent School District to better support academic programs and operational efficiencies.

2025-2026 Attendance Zone Recommendation Summary

Elementary Schools

1. Rolling Meadows ES

 Entire Retama Springs subdivision at Kentucky Ridge to include a smaller subdivision south of Retama Springs at Lookout Rd near Creekside Hill rezoned to Selma ES (44 students).

2. Coronado Village ES

- Relocate all admin, staff, and students to Selma ES.
- Dual Language program moves to Selma ES.

3. Wortham Oaks ES

• Sunset the Spanish Immersion (SI) Program after all the currently enrolled SI students complete the program.

4. Attendance Zone Adjustments

- Copperfield ES: A portion of Copperfield ES rezoned to Converse ES that would include 95 students in a triangular area including South Seguin Rd, North Seguin Rd/Kneupper Rd, and FM 78.
- Escondido ES: A portion of Escondido ES rezoned to Elolf ES that would include 245 students
 located south of Walzem Rd to include the Norte 8833 Apartments and two subdivisions
 named Liberte Preserve and Liberte Creek.
- Olympia ES: A portion of Olympia ES was originally recommended to be rezoned to Selma ES that would include 45 students located south of I-35 to remain at Olympia ES.
 However, an amended recommendation is to allow those 45 students to remain at Olympia ES. (32 students net going to Selma ES from Rolling Meadows ES)

Middle Schools

- 1. Candlewood ES
 - Move from Metzger MS feeder pattern to Kirby MS feeder pattern.
- 2. Park Village ES
 - Move from Kirby MS feeder pattern to Woodlake Hills MS feeder pattern.
- 3. JSTEM
 - Relocate to Kitty Hawk MS.

High Schools

- 1. Wagner HS
 - Feeder schools: Kirby MS and Metzger MS
- 2. Judson HS
 - Feeder schools: Judson MS and Woodlake Hills MS
- 3. Veterans Memorial HS
 - Feeder schools: Cibolo Creek ES and Kitty Hawk MS

 - Ensures equitable student distribution across campuses.

 - Present Plan 2 to the school board for review and feedback.

- 2. Closing Judson Middle School:
 - Potential consolidation of resources and students.
- 3. Designating Cibolo Creek Middle School as a STEM Campus:
 - Specialized programming focused on science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.




- Elementary School Recommendation Overview

 - Spanish Immersion program sunsets at Wortham Oaks Elementary




Additional Elementary Recommendations
