## About TOLI

The Olga Lengyel Institute for Holocaust Studies and Human Rights (TOLI) grew from the vision of Olga Lengyel, a Holocaust survivor who lost her parents, her husband, and their two young sons at Auschwitz. In 1947, Olga published *Five Chimneys: A Woman Survivor's True Story of Auschwitz*, one of the earliest volumes of Holocaust testimony. Thirty years later, her vivid exposé of the death camps became one of the haunting accounts that inspired William Styron's award-winning novel, *Sophie's Choice*. Spending her later years in New York City, Olga dedicated her legacy to educating future generations about the Holocaust.

Entering its twelfth year, our cornerstone program in Manhattan – The Memorial Library Summer Seminar for middle school, high school and college faculty – has helped to bring the lessons of the Holocaust into today's world for thousands of students in schools across the United States and, increasingly, overseas. The majority of teachers who are accepted into our summer seminar come from public schools with the next largest group from parochial schools and a small percentage from independent schools. Our academic faculty, led by Dr. Sondra Perl, employs a unique methodology based in writing and inquiry while providing participants with opportunities to experience the vibrancy and diversity of contemporary Jewish life.
