Requirements Product Process Procedure

### **Requirements of EPP**

- Describe personal, academic, and career interests
- Describe personal, educational, and career goals (short-term and long-term)
- Identify "next steps" requirements following high school completion and steps for successful transition:2-year, 4-year college or university, career school, apprenticeship, workforce, military

#### These three are currently documented in:

- Naviance annual survey
- Future Focus ppt.
- Future Focus essay

# **Requirements of EPP cont.**

 Plan courses and learning experiences that support the student's interests and goals, including: opportunities for meeting academic standards, essential skills, technical knowledge and skills, extended application, and participation in careerrelated learning experiences.

#### This currently takes place in the:

- Naviance annual survey
- Naviance course planner used during forecasting each spring

# **Requirements of EPP cont.**

- Documentation of personal progress and achievement toward:
  - Academic standards <u>transcript</u>
  - Essential skills OAKS assessment summary
  - CRLS will fold into either career pathways or Senior Capstone
  - Extended application <u>Senior Capstone</u>
  - CRLEs will fold into either career pathways
    or Senior Capstone
  - Credit requirements transcript

# **Requirements of EPP cont.**

- Record of personal awards, accomplishments, experiences, and skills.
  - Naviance Resume
- Reflections on current status of personal, educational, and career goals.
  - Future Focus

#### **Products:** All currently housed in Naviance

- <u>Naviance Survey</u> a new one each year, 2012 Freshman EPP, 2012 Sophomore EPP, 2012 Junior EPP, 2012 Senior EPP.
- **Future Focus Power Point, "Who Am I?"** both in class and online Moodle option would include this.
- **<u>Future Focus Essay</u>** This is the freshman level research paper.
- <u>**\*Transcript**</u> A proposal is being turned into MESD to re-design our transcript so that it comprehensively documents:
  - Academic standards
  - Essential skills
  - CRLS/CRLEs
  - Extended Application
  - Credit requirements
- <u>Summary of Progress</u> will be completed for each student on cardstock that can be shared with parents

\*Alternate Plan if Transcript is not updated: Registrar maintains a database documenting all requirements (as outlined on the attachment) per kid

### Process

#### For Naviance Survey:

- First Sweep Naviance Survey in Advisory All grades
- Second Sweep Sent an email explaining this is a graduation requirement to all in progress and all non-started students; asked them to complete the survey.
- Third Sweep While doing forecasting with all freshmen, complete the survey as an exit slip. Can't leave until it's done!
- Final Sweep Kid's that didn't forecast or do the survey are called in to complete both tasks.
- Current number of completers as of 4/10/09: 216, 38 IP, 25 NS

### **Process cont.**

#### For Future Focus PPT. and Essay

- Both are completed in Future Focus class, which is a requirement for all freshmen this year and is a graduation requirement for all future students.
- The kid doesn't pass the class without completing these two projects.
- These two assignments are uploaded into students Naviance accounts.

## Procedure

- Who does what, when and where?
  - <u>Registrar</u> (with re-aligned duties) maintains the centralized system of documentation. Sends monthly reports to counselors for catch up planning.
  - <u>Counselors</u> conduct the "sweeps" mentioned above
  - <u>Future Focus teachers</u> facilitate learning and planning through "Who Am I?" ppt. and research paper.

## **Procedure Cont.**

- Senior project advisors / advisory teachers monitor and manage the Extended Application (Capstone)
- <u>Career Pathways Teachers</u> provide both CRLS and CRLE's within content
- <u>Administrative Team</u> plan and communicate new requirements within Career Pathway classes. Conduct monthly audits of progress.
