Item Name: CONSIDER APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A STATE WAIVER TO THE TEXAS

**EDUCATION AGENCY** 

**Item Summary:** On the afternoon of Monday, April 3, 2023, a social media threat was made against Briscoe Junior High School, about events that would take place on Tuesday, April 4. The District notified parents late on the evening of April 3 that the threat was not credible, and that additional security would be available on campus the following day. As a result, the attendance rate for Briscoe Junior High School on Tuesday, April 4, 2023, was 75.41% versus a normal Average Daily Attendance of 94.15% registered during the 2021-2022 school year.

Per the Texas Education Agency's (TEA) Student Attendance Accounting Handbook (SAAH), districts that experience a decline of Average Daily Attendance at a specific campus on a specific day of 10% or greater due to weather, health, or safety related issues can request a Low-Attendance Day Waiver to have the day excluded from overall calculations.

**Recommendation:** Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees authorize the Superintendent to submit a Low-Attendance Day Waiver to have Tuesday, April 4, 2023 excluded from Average Daily Attendance calculations for Briscoe Junior High School.
