







## Board Talking Points March 2022

Spring is right around the corner, marking the annual time of renewal. A sense of optimism is in the air as we move toward a more positive stage of the pandemic, resulting in school safety plans changes. As I pen this document, the following is in place:

- The indoor mask requirement for Oregon, including schools, will be lifted on March 11. Thus, masks will no longer be required for staff and students.
- Governor Brown also lifted the state emergency order on April 1. This is more of a technicality with little impact on schools.
- The vaccination requirement for school and health care staff will remain in place. The vaccination requirement for other government officials will be lifted.
- These changes will require modifications to our safety plans. On March 2, ODE released modifications to RSSL requirements, resulting in local decision-making and coordination with Local Public Health authorities.

It has been a long haul. COVID created polarization in our communities, which presented immense challenges to school boards and superintendents. Throughout it all, you successfully navigated the myriad of changes with your communities. I am proud of how eastern Oregon handled the crisis. Better days are on the horizon as we move into spring.
