EARLY ENTRANCE

Early Entry policy information shall be disseminated each spring through such mediums as the press and district publications. Applications will be available at the District Office.

1. APPLICATION PROCESS:

- a. The application form must be complete.
- b. An official record of birth and proof of immunization must accompany the application.
- c. A fee as determined by the Board of Directors is required and must be included with the application. The fee requirement will be waived if financial hardship is claimed.
- d. Applications must be filed at the District Office before the start of the school year
- e. Applications received after the start of the current school year shall be considered only for the ensuing year.
- f. Applications shall be submitted to the District Office.

2. ASSESSMENT:

- a. Assessments are to be completed by September 15 June 30.
- b. An initial screening assessment (e.g. AGS: Early Screening Profiles) will be conducted at the District Office by a qualified tester. Students must score in the 90th percentile or higher on the Cognitive/Language Profile. No further evaluation will be completed unless the child meets the minimum score requirement.
- c. For children qualified to continue the assessment process, a parent interview will be conducted to evaluate social behaviors (e.g. Vineland Social-Emotional Early Childhood Scales). Criteria for early entry will be adaptive scores falling at or above the adequate adaptive level.
- d. The final assessment will be a measure of motor skills development (e.g. Modified Capon's Perceptual Motor Program).

3. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- a. Assessment and observation information, accompanied by the application for early entry, will be submitted to an advisory team.
- b. The advisory team will be comprised of the test administrator, building principal, Talented/Gifted Coordinator and two building principals.
- c. The advisory team will make recommendations for early entry.
- d. The decision shall be given to the parent(s) following completion of the assessment, observations, and advisory team meeting no later than June 30.
- e. The final decision of the advisory team cannot be appealed.
