# **Elementary Programs**

- We currently serve 3,902 K-5 students in art in music.
- Meridith-Dunbar provides an Art para-professional that works with our 391 Pre-K students
- Total Pre-K-5: 4,293 students receive regular Fine Arts instruction in TISD



# **Elementary Programs**

In Temple ISD, we have certified music and art specialists at all 8 elementary campuses. We also have an art para-professional at Meridith-Dunbar Early Childhood Academy.

All elementary students participate in art and music at least once a week (depending on schedule).





# **Elementary Orchestra**

- TISD currently offers beginning string instruction to 5th grade students at all elementary schools
- This program currently averages 100 5th grade




















# **High School Programs**

# Accomplishments

### Accomplishments

- UIL Marching Band Straight Superior Ratings and Advanced to Area
- UIL Concert/Sight-Reading 6 bands, 5 orchestras, and 11 choirs participated in this event. Groups consistently received "Superior" or "Excellent" ratings with 10 Sweepstakes awards.

- 21 High School Art Entries in VASE
  - 16 received Gold Medal awards
  - 3 qualified for State VASE contest

  - 28 Gold Medals
  - 2 Platinum Medals (MS equivalent of HS State)

- THS Theatre 6 students advanced from state to NATIONALS for International Thespians.
