Administrative Recommendation	The Crosby ISD Administration recommends approving an Interlocal Agreement(s) for Law Enforcement Services with the Harris County Precinct 3 Constables Office, October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027 for \$947,800.00.
Authority for this Action	TEC 37.081 – (a) The board of trustees of any school district may employ security personnel, enter into a memorandum of understanding with a local law enforcement agency for the provision of school resource officers, and commission peace officers to carry out this subchapter. If a board of trustees authorizes a person employed as security personnel to carry a weapon, the person must be a commissioned peace officer. The jurisdiction of a peace officer, a school resource officer, or security personnel under this section shall be determined by the board of trustees and may include all territory in the boundaries of the school district and all property outside the boundaries of the district that is owned, leased, or rented by or otherwise under the control of the school district and the board of trustees that employ the peace officer or security personnel or that enter into a memorandum of understanding for the provision of a school resource officer.
Goal/Objective Addressed	District Improvement Plan Goal 8: Crosby ISD will maintain quality and safe facilities and adequately plan for future needs
Background	Crosby ISD has contracted with the Harris County Precinct 3 Constables Office for district law enforcement and security services in recent history. Crosby ISD added one additional officer during the 2021-2022 school year, and two additional officers during the 2022-2023 school year, bringing the total number of constables serving the district to ten. The proposed agreement would continue with the total number of constables serving Crosby ISD as ten, beginning October 1, 2026. Contract terms specify that Crosby ISD pay 70% of each constable's salary and the remaining 30% will be paid by Harris County.

Impact of this Action	Approval of this action will allow Crosby ISD to continue to contract with the county for a total of ten constables beginning October 1, 2026.
