REVIEW JOINT MEETING MINUTES OF APRIL 21, 2022 is approved.

John Hopson Jr MOVED to APPROVE the minutes. Roxanne Brower SECONDED the motion. Question called, no objections. The motion carried UNANIMOUSLY.

OPENING COMMENTS AND SHARING INITIATIVES is provided by Justina Wilhelm, Ilisagvik College President, and David Vadiveloo, NSBSD Superintendent and each respective administration on institutional updates and shared initiatives on the joint memorandum, Ilisaurriguqta Program, Qatqiññiagvik, and the Nunaaqqiurat Tumitchianjit.

Discussion regarded: registration fees and tuition waivers; organizational contributions for dual credit student participation; separate MOAs for students and staff; staff training on cultural safety and student wellness; communication of programs and offerings; student credit weight; internet and connectivity issues and participation in programs; and definition of Qatqiññiaġvik.

STUDENT VOICE – SUPPORTS WE NEED TO SUCCEED is provided by Ilisagivik College Student Government representatives and Magdelina Stringer, Student Representative on the Board.

Discussion regarded: providing more in-person classes and varying class time offerings; student homesickness; More in-depth/extended sessions on mental health, substance abuse, etc...; and career exploration from 9-12th Grade.

ILUAGNIQPUT – OUR WELLBEING is a facilitated discussion to articulate collaboration between Ilisagvik College and NSBSD to foster student success by addressing student wellness.

Discussion regarded: mentorships, guest speakers, presenters on opportunities for tradeschools, careers, cultural experts, etc...; college preparation program and communication for student career awareness; Dual credit and internet connectivity difficulty; improving communication on opportunities, utilizing social media; increasing on-the-job-training student relevance and rigor; additional/extended session on mental health curriculum; Ilisaġvik College liaisons in each school; Advanced placement course offering; increased peer interaction opportunities or peer cohort; student cohort coherence with counselor and advisor coordination; community involvement for staff recruitment and retention; personal finance and life skills class offerings; study hall time with dedicated tutors; facilitator for dedicated communication for students with families; committees on student wellness and communications; facilitation and alignment of retention and homegrown staff; and education of staff on resources available to students.

READING AND APPROVAL OF JOINT RESOLUTION FOR COLLABORATIVE WORK is approved UNANIMOUSLY.

CLOSING REMARKS: Each organization's present members provided closing remarks highlighting discussion points from the joint meeting.
