# SCIENCE PROJECTS

Interested in a Science Fair project this spring?  
Ready to try something new in Science class? In any class?  
This is a great time of year to check out Science Project resources!

- It doesn't have to be anything huge!
  - Use that experiment or activity you've been putting off
  - Go a quick online search for "each homeschool science experiments" and see what you have at home!
- Add an extra research component (combine with a language arts unit)
  - Focus on the Scientific Method
- Create a physical component
  - Incorporate play doh, stickers, paper mache, any crafts from your cupboard!
- Share with your PACE teacher (we'd love to see it or even display it, if possible)
  - Some areas have local Science Fairs; we'd be happy to help see if you can participate!
- Create a Project Fair in your home
  - Could be any topic that fits into your curriculum in any subject (history, social studies, art, famous poet, book report)
- Include students of multiple ages
  - Scaffold the activities for each grade so everyone can participate (check out free printables for early ages)
- Don't feel like you need to do it now; summer is a great opportunity for a longer learning opportunity
- Check out your local library for Science Fair resources (and sometimes even supplies!)
- Channel Ms. Frizzle: *"Take chances, make mistakes, and get messy!"*
