TOPIC: Approval of Purchase Digital Licenses for Middle School World and US History

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of digital licenses from Cengage Learning in Independence, Kentucky for Middle School World History and US History for \$121,433.00. This purchase would extend digital access to the current Board approved textbooks of *World History, Ancient to Early Modern Times* and *US History American Stories, Beginnings to 1877* for two-years.

RATIONALE:

The textbook was evaluated using the district textbook adoption process in 2018 and the extension will provide continued access to the digital textbook. The recommendation has been reviewed and supported by the Curriculum Committee.

BUDGETARY INFORMATION:

The funding for this purchase will come from Academic Services Department Secondary Textbook Funds, which is supported by Wayne County Enhancement Milage.
