Since we don't have 20 ELL students that 5% (5 points) is spread out over ELA Proficiency, Math Proficiency, Science Proficiency, ELA Growth, and MAP Growth. For example ELA Growth is worth 25% of our score, but with the ELL points added it is now 26.79%.

Proficiency- there is a target that you have to hit each year, and that goes up every year. We met in Science, Math, and ELA proficiency Targets. As you can see from the chart, we got all the points for proficiency.

Growth is a 2 year score. So 6th graders are based on scores from 4th, 5th and 6th. What they do is they compare all the students as 5th graders who had the same score. For example they look at all the students who scored 750 in 5th grade. They then put their 6th grade scores in order from the highest to the lowest. Those with the best score get the highest %, and it works its way down. Our Growth Scores are very good.

ELA Growth Score was 84.52 Math Growth Score was 84.27

As you can see from the chart we made gains in both ELA Growth and Math Growth.

Chronic Absenteeism- is the % of students who miss 10% or more of the school year. To calculate the points they put the schools in order in terms of % of students who are chronically absent. So those with the fewest get the higher amount of points.

Climate Survey- is the 5 Essential Survey. Our score is based on the % of students who take it. We got all the points here, and we had over 95% of our students take it.
