TOPIC:

Approval to Purchase Curriculum Materials for Jackson Early Childhood Center

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District purchase Creative Curriculum Materials and Resources for use in our infant, two-year old, preschool, and Young 5's classrooms for \$31,675.00. This purchase includes print and digital materials for teachers, and books and materials for students.

RATIONALE:

After our Early Childhood Accreditation review, Carol Carignan, Lead Administrator for Jackson Center, and her team used our district textbook adoption process to review pilot materials. They recommend a purchase of the Creative Curriculum for preschool, infants, toddlers, and two-year old students.

The funding for this purchase will come from the Elementary Textbook funds, which have been supported through the Wayne County Enhancement Milage monies.
