Attendance Boundary Rezoning Presented to the Denton ISD Board of Trustees



### The Process



- An email was sent on October 15, 2024, to all potentially affected families including an overview video and a link to provide feedback via ThoughtExchange.
- The ThoughtExchange opened on October 15th to gather feedback from the community about their priorities for potential rezoning. The ThoughtExchange closed on October 18th.
- Community meetings were held on two nights at four locations:
  - October 21st at Calhoun Middle School
  - October 21st at Harpool Middle School
  - October 23rd at McMath Middle School
  - October 23rd at Nelson Elementary School
- All proposed boundary changes were posted on the <u>www.dentonisd.org/rezone</u> website on October 15th.
- New attendance boundaries will go into effect for the 2025-2026 school year; finalized attendance boundary maps will be posted on the district website.

## Request to Remain

- All families being rezoned will have the opportunity to request to remain at their current campus.
- The request to remain will open on January 6, 2025. We request that all requests to remain are completed by February 28, 2025.
- District guidelines for transfers will remain in effect for students remaining at their current campus.










### **Evers Elementary**

The Evers Elementary attendance zone is denoted in brown






### **Newton Rayzor Elementary**

The Newton Rayzor Elementary attendance zone is denoted in purple






### **Borman Elementary**







The Nelson Elementary attendance zone is denoted in mint green






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


