Discussion of Health Benefit Changes for 2011

Sally Havey, Benefits Coordinator for Denton ISD, updated the board on the health benefit changes for 2011. Mrs. Havey suggested eliminating the Molloy Wellness program as it currently, costs the district almost \$700,000 per year. Also, to comply with the new federal legislation, Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, the following possible plan changes were outlined to the board:

- Chiropractic benefits to change to an annual 30-visit limit.
- Eligible dependents to be covered to age 26.
- No pre-existing condition penalty for dependents under the age of 19.
- Unlimited lifetime maximums

Sally Havey provided information to the Board regarding the recommendation for the 2011 Employee Health Insurance On-Line Enrollment Program. The recommendation is to remain with the district's current vendor, Core Source, due to price considerations and no disruption to the employee population.

Summer School Report The Board received a report on the 2010 Summer School Programs. The report stated that there were 60 fifth-grade students who attended for reading assistance and 79 attended for math instruction at the same grade level. In the high school ESL program, there were 98 students who attended – with 90 of those earning credit for their summer work. In the general high school program, 141 students attended with 125 earning ½ credit or more.

2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Growth Report Rod Reeves, Facility Coordinator presented the Board with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Growth Report. Since the first quarter of 2009, the closing number for new home activity has fluctuated below and above 250. In the second quarter, that closing number grew to 289 - 41 above the starting number and the highest since 2008. Because of the recent tax credit deadline, the remainder of 2010 will likely show a lower rate of starts and sales. Among other DFW school districts, Denton ranks third in annual new home starts. The district shows growth comparable to other DFW school districts:
