This month the Technology Department worked on the following projects:

- Completed the online testing for TELPAS testing of ESL students.
- Worked with maintenance toward getting the new marquee at OHS mounted and going.
- Worked with Ener-tel completing the annual fire alarm inspection of each building in the district, testing each pull down notifier, each strobe light, each alarm bell, etc.
- Worked to update and clean up all the iPad carts. We also attended a seminar on mobile management, looking at ways to simplify the management of our mobile devices.
- Worked with Ener-Tel on repairing cameras and looking at replacing the outdated systems of DVRs at each campus. Looking at going toward a more central recording structure and adding additional cameras in blind spots.

- Worked at OHS with printing issues in the Heritage building.
- Worked with maintenance on timeclock issues.
