Three local vendors were mailed bid packets (e.g. Wendy's, McDonald's, and Chick-fil-a) for prepared breaded chicken sandwiches for Coppell High School for the 2004 - 2005 school year. The Request for Proposal (RFP) purchasing method was utilized to obtain quotes.

The local Wendy's and McDonald's chose not to quote due to not offering a school delivery program for hot sandwiches. Chick-fil-a bid \$2.00 per sandwich delivered. Chick-fil-a has a recognized school food program that meets or exceeds all district specifications, State nutrition guidelines, and health department guidelines. Their sandwich has been a popular choice among students for the past several years at the high school. The sandwich will retail for \$3.00.
